

LAKWOOD CHRISTIAN CAMPGROUND TRANSIENT RULES AND REGULATIONS 2022

BOOKING -The deposit required upon booking is the first night's stay plus a \$5 reservation fee. For holiday weekends, a deposit of the entire stay is required

CANCELLATION - The reservation fee is non-refundable. The first night deposit is refundable with at least two weeks' notice before the arrival date. For holiday weekends, with at least two weeks' notice, the deposit less one night and the reservation fee will be refunded.

CHECK-IN- Check in time is 2:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. and check out time is 11:00 a.m. Fees may apply outside these hours.

GATE CARDS -Weekly and overnight campers can receive a gate card for \$20.00 and will be refunded \$15.00 when returned in working condition.

Please do not press the call button for re-entry between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. If you exit the campground and return during these hours without obtaining a gate card first, please park in the parking lot. If gate cards are found in the hands of friends, or any person other than those registered, the cards will be removed and passes revoked.

SPEED - Obey the speed limit of 15½ km/hr for the safety of our children. Warning will be issued once. After that, vehicles will be parked and walking will be enforced. All rules of the highway traffic act apply in this campground.

VEHICLES/PARKING - Two cars per site, all other vehicles must be parked in the parking lot. If your vehicles do not fit on your site, **please do not park on the road or vacant lots.** Ask management for an appropriate spot to park. Boats, sea-dos, hard-tops, trailers for loading materials, etc. are not allowed on the lot, but have to be parked in an area to be specified by management and there will be a fee applied. Vehicles are not to be washed at any time. No motorcycles, mini-bikes, or ATVs allowed on campground property without authorization from management. **All vehicles in the campground, including the parking lot, must be registered in the store. Any unregistered vehicles may be towed.**

HYDRO ON WATER ONLY SITES – is available at shared locations in “water only” site areas. Please be respectful to fellow campers around you and share the power. Do not leave items plugged in for prolonged periods of time. **ELECTRIC CARS** – Charging of any electric vehicle is prohibited.

BICYCLES- NO BIKE RIDING AFTER DARK!! Parents are responsible for the safety of their own children regarding the use of safety equipment.

PETS - Pets are welcome, as long as they are kept on a leash at all times, quiet, and never left unattended. Pick up after your pets immediately, put waste into a securely tied plastic bag, and deposit into the garbage container. No pets allowed in the playground, pool, in any park buildings, or on other campsites. At the discretion of the campground owner, any pet can be denied or banned from the park.

GUESTS- Camping rates per site are for 2 adults and their dependent children 18 years and under. Any additional visitors are subject to visitor fees. You are responsible for your guests. Ensure that your visitors have paid to enter the park. If they do not, you are responsible. Day visitors must arrive before 9:00 p.m., and must leave by 10:00 p.m.

POOL -Please respect the supervisor at all times. The supervisor may revoke your pool privileges if you do not obey the posted pool rules.

NOTE: All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older. When the supervisor is on duty, your children are still your responsibility. The pool may be closed due to inclement weather, or low usages, subject to our discretion.

BEACH - Please use the McEwan Park path when going to the beach.

GARBAGE - Only household garbage is allowed in the bins. Please bring garbage to the front dumpster if you can.

QUIET TIME - Quiet time is between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. Show consideration to your neighbours! No radios, T.V., or any musical instruments played outside your trailer after 11:00 p.m., or any other noise which will disturb campers, including lawnmowers and power tools.

CAMPFIRES - Campfires are allowed in existing fire pits only and must be contained to the size of the fire pit. All campfires must be attended at all times and must be completely extinguished before you leave, or retire for the evening. Please do not move fire pits. We encourage all campers to purchase firewood at the Lakewood Christian Campground store to help stop the spread of disease and insects harming the trees.

TREES - Cutting or mutilating trees in the campground is strictly prohibited. Please, no clothes lines attached to trees!! Attaching anything to the trees in any way is prohibited for the health and protection of the trees. Any alteration to landscaping requires management approval. No digging unless prior authorization has been obtained. **Please use breathable grass mats only on the grass.**

ALCOHOL - Alcoholic beverages must be consumed on your campsite only. No glass containers are permitted. Excessive drinking and/or unruly behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction without refund. Please keep your site tidy.

SMOKING - Smoking is strictly prohibited in any of our buildings as well as a 20 metre perimeter around buildings. Smoking is also strictly prohibited in the playground, pool area, and any other recreational areas along with a 20 metre perimeter around those areas.

FIREWORKS - Any fireworks other than scheduled fireworks by management are prohibited.

GOLF CARTS – Golf carts not permitted for overnight campers unless there is proof of disability.

ETIQUETTE - Practice good camping manners by respecting the property and privacy of other individuals. Please do not take shortcuts through campsites. Aggressive action (verbal or physical) toward another person will not be tolerated. In addition, any violation of any federal, provincial or municipal laws by a camper, or his/her guests, will likely result in eviction. If your noise disturbs either your neighbour or the owners, then it is too loud. If you are impeding the enjoyment of anyone around you, or in the park, it may lead to eviction.

EMERGENCIES - In case of emergencies, call 911, and then notify the office at 519-899-4415, so ambulance can be directed as quickly as possible to the correct area or lot. A first aid kit is available at the store and at the pool. There are 2 AED's in the park. One is located on the front laundry room. The second is located in the Fellowship Hall washroom area.

The campground reserves the right to ask any camper to leave the campground for non-compliance with the above rules, or any other reasonable request made to discontinue conduct or noise offensive in any way to the management or any other camper. Rules are subject to change without notice.

We strive to provide a pleasant, safe, wholesome, neat, and clean environment that all campers can share, enjoy, and take pride in. We need and appreciate your co-operation in order to make camping a positive experience for everyone. Please feel free to inform us of any condition requiring our attention.
